Review each step in the JHA asking these questions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Is there a danger of the employee striking against, being struck by, or otherwise making injurious contact with an object? • Can an employee be caught in, by, or between objects? • Is there potential for slipping, tripping or falling? • Could the employee suffer strains from moving small gear, pushing, pulling, lifting, bending or twisting? • Is the environment hazardous to safety and/or health (e.g. toxic gas, vapor, mist, fumes, dust, heat or radiation)? (see MSDS) • What potential system or equipment failures could cause bodily injury? • Is the position the employee will have to work in likely to put them in harms way or cause cramping, strains etc? • What energy sources are present? (e.g. pressures, electrical, steam, temperature extremes, chemical). • Is the work area or work performed involved in a high noise level condition? • Is there a potential for an LOC incident while completing this task? • Has every effort been made to protect the environment? 				

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SEQUENCE OF DETAILED JOB STEPS	POTENTIAL HAZARDS	RECOMMENDATIONS TO ELIMINATE OR REDUCE HAZARDS

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For Level 2 JHAs (Common Jobs) Only: JHA must be reviewed at the work site confirming that there are no changes to the job plan and all hazards are identified. Any changes in the process must be documented in the JHA for future reference. All personnel performing the work must sign the JHA. ***Senior Licensed Supervisor acknowledgement required only when changes are identified.** Common jobs are those jobs that are part of the day to day activities of the crew, and have a well established procedure with associated risks identified for those jobs.
